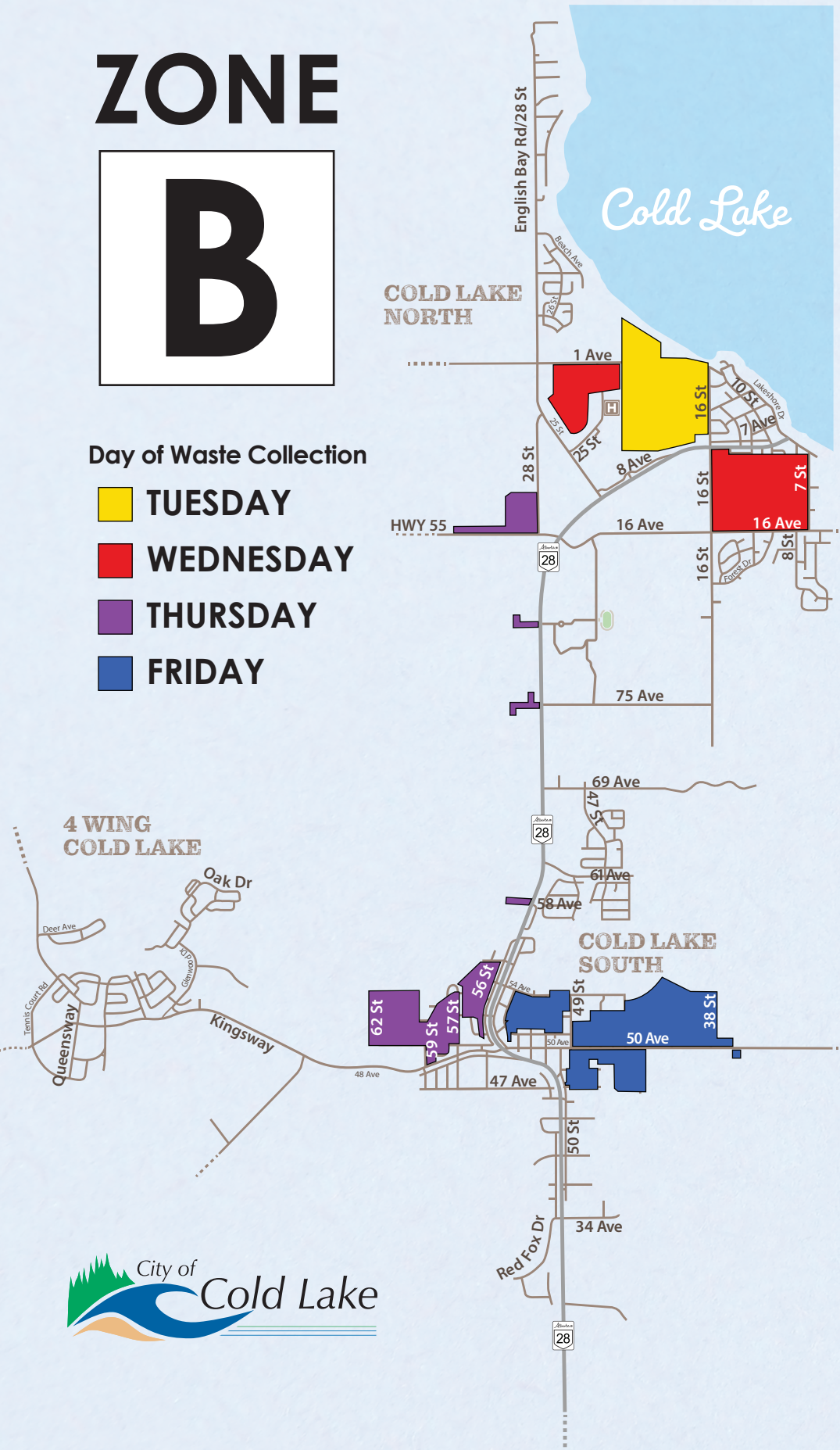

Materials must be curbside by 7:00 am to ensure collection

Regular Garbage (collected every week)

- If the City has provided a waste cart, it is the only container from which garbage will be collected.
- If the City has not provided a waste cart, garbage is limited to three (3) bags, each weighing no more than 20 kg. (45 lbs.) and with a maximum volume of 100 litres.

Recycling (collected every two weeks)

- There is no limit to amount of recyclables accepted for collection.
- All containers must be rinsed. **Glass and styrofoam are not accepted.**

- Recyclables can also be dropped off at Recycle Drop-off locations (Energy Drive-Energy Centre & 4811 50 St.) or the Material Recycling Facility at Cold Lake Transfer Station.



Organics (April 1 - Nov. 15)

- If the City has provided an organics cart, it is the only container from which organics will be collected.
- If the City has not provided an organics cart, organics is limited to ten (10) bags or containers of organic waste plus five (5) bundles of branches or brush.
- No animal waste, no ashes, or cat litter.**
- No noxious weeds (Accepted at Cold Lake Transfer Station)**
- Organics must be placed in provided organics cart.
- If an organics cart is not provided, heavy paper OR compostable bags OR a can affixed with an organics label are acceptable. Labels available FREE from Public Works or City Hall.
- Only approved compostable bags identified by the following logos are acceptable for pickup at the curb:

Containers or uncollected materials must be removed from the curb by 9:00 pm the day of collection.

Alternatives to Landfill (not collected at the curb)

- Materials not collected at the curb can be diverted through the 3Rs: Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle.
- Recyclables can also be dropped off at Recycle Drop-off locations (Energy Drive-Energy Centre & 4811 50 St.)

Accepted at Cold Lake Waste Management Facility (drop off)

- Batteries**
- Compact fluorescent lights and tubes**
- E-Waste** (TVs, Computers, Microwaves, etc.)
- Household Hazardous Waste**
- Mixed Metals**
- Paint, Oil** (Automotive, Containers, Filters)
- Tires** (Rims Removed)
