Memorialization

Limestone niche doors may be engraved with a name, date of birth and death, and a short message. To have an inscription made on a columbarium door, please submit the following to the City:

- Memorial Permit Application form
- Memorial Permit Fee \$75

The City will arrange for the inscriptions to be completed, in accordance with established design specifications, and installed on the columbarium. Applicants will be responsible for the costs of engraving.

Columbaria

A Columbarium is a permanent structure designed as a final resting place for cremated remains. The columbaria have compartments (called a "niche") which are available for reservation in advance or purchase when needed.

There are five columbaria at the Lakeview Cemetery. Three of the columbaria – named Pine, Spruce and Fir – each have 66 niches, facing east and west. There are also two smaller columbaria – named Aspen and Birch – which have 18 niches, facing north and south. There are two columbaria at the Grand Centre Memorial Park Cemetery named Loon and Warbler, which have 66 niches, facing east and west.

As the space inside the niche is limited, be mindful when selecting urn sizes to allow room for multiple urns inside the niche.

Niche Purchase

Each of the columbarium have niches available in two sizes:

- (1) **Single Niche** 12"h x 12"w x 15"d Holds a maximum of two urns. Plot purchase fees are: \$1,250.00 (resident rate) or \$1,875.00 (non-resident rate)
- (2) **Double Niche** 12" h x 24"w x 15"d Holds a maximum of 4 urns. Plot purchase fees are: \$2,500.00 (resident rate) and \$3,750.00 (non-resident rate)

To purchase a columbarium niche, please submit the following to the City:

- Application for Interment Right
- Plot fee

A maximum of 4 plots or niches can be purchased per applicant. Only one niche may be registered per person. Niches must be registered in the name of the 'Interment Rights Holder'.

Interment

Once the columbarium niche has been purchased, the interment (placing an urn into the columbarium) can be arranged. To place an urn into a columbarium, the following documents must be submitted to the City at least 24 hours prior to the interment service:

- · Interment Authorization form
- Cremation Certificate
- Opening/closing fee (\$100) and Interment administrative fee (\$75)

The City will open the niche before the service and close the niche following the conclusion of the service. Removal of an urn from a columbarium will require an Application for Disinterment to be submitted to the City.

A "resident" is defined as a person who lives within the jurisdiction of the City of Cold Lake at the time the cemetery product or service is purchased and includes a person who has lived in the City of Cold Lake, Town of Grand Centre, Town of Cold Lake, and/or Medley for at least 15 years at any point in his or her life.
