

# COLD LAKE REGIONAL AIRPORT

## Home to a variety of fixed-wing aircraft, the Cold Lake Regional Airport is an unmanned runway used by many local and visiting pilots to the area.

The Cold Lake Regional Airport (CEN5) occupies a land area of approximately 99.5 hectares. While the airport was initially developed by the Province of Alberta in 1979, it was transferred to the City of Cold Lake in 1997. Since that time, the City has acted as the airport's owner and operator.

#### **LOCATION**

The airport is 4 km west of the City of Cold Lake and 7 km north of CFB 4 Wing Cold Lake, at 63407 Range Road 425, M.D. of Bonnyville.

#### **RUNWAY**

The asphalt runway is designated 08-26 and is 914.4 m (3,000 ft) in length and 22.86 m (75 ft) wide. A public apron measuring 45.7 m (150 ft) by 76.2 m (250 ft) is located to the south of runway threshold 08 and is connected to the runway via paved taxiway "A".

#### **AIRFIELD LIGHTING**

Controlled by ARCAL Type K (aircraft radio control of aerodrome lighting).

#### **HANGARS**

All hangars on the site are privately owned. Lots are leased from the City of Cold Lake. A grass tie-down area is also available.

The Cold Lake Regional Airport is selfregister and self-serve, meaning pilots and aircraft users have access to the fuel pumps whenever required. Assistance and leasing is available through Public Works during regular business hours.


#### **NEARBY AIRPORT**

4 Wing Cold Lake at CFB Cold Lake YOD is owned by His Majesty the King as represented by the Minister of National Defense. Primarily used by the Royal Canadian Armed Forces for daily operations. It is also used by allied and friendly air forces accessing the Cold Lake Air Weapons Range for training or air combat exercises. Some charter use outside of military operations take place from time to time.

The Cold Lake Regional Airport features Global Positioning System (GPS) and Wide Area Augmentation System (WAAS) approaches. This state-of-the art satellite navigation has increased the level of safety for both aircraft operators and carriers.

#### **AIRFIELD LIGHTING**

Airfield lighting is controlled by ARCAL Type K (aircraft radio control of aerodrome lighting). The radio frequency to control the lighting is 122.8.
