City approval of this application will grant the applicant a license to keep hens for the duration of one year commencing on the date that the license is issued to the applicant (July 1- June 30). The license will expire after one year, and the applicant will need to renew their license to further keep hens in their back yard.

Prior to completing this application form, applicants must read the Urban Hen Keeping Bylaw (704-AD-21). Failure to maintain and abide by all requirements of the Urban Hen Keeping Bylaw (704-AD-21), the Urban Hen Keeping Guidelines and/or applicable Provincial regulations will lead to a license being revoked, and the hens must be removed from the property at the applicant's expense.

Keeping hens without a license will result in a charge under the Animal Care and Control Bylaw (535-PL-14), and the Urban Hen Keeping Bylaw (704-AD-21).
